



In February 2011 we signed a contract with Misty May to conduct her M2 volleyball camp at the Waupaca Boatride Volleyball Tournament. However, in March 2011 Misty and Kerri Walsh decided to qualify for the 2012 London Olympic Games. We have had lengthy conversations with Misty and her management team about her decision, and we understand and fully support Misty and her dream of winning a 3rd Olympic gold medal. We also did not want to be known in the volleyball world as the event that prevented her from reaching her goal because of a signed contract. We are obligated to announce that Misty May will not be at the camps - as she will be in Europe for qualification events for the Olympics.

The M2 Camp will go on as planned- with the following coaches in attendance:

- Butch May - Misty's Father, Trainer, and 1968 Olympian
- Christie Phillips – Misty's Manager, Trainer, and head of M2 Volleyball Camps
- Patricia Daugherty- USA Volleyball High Performance Coach
- Several AVP players and college coaches from around the country

When we partnered with Misty and her camps, it was with the intention of a long term relationship. With Misty's decision, she will not be in attendance for the 2011 and 2012 M2 Camps – however she will be back in 2013 (hopefully with the 3rd gold medal in hand!).

Our goal with the Waupaca Boatride Volleyball camps is to offer the best volleyball skills camp for the most affordable price. The normal cost to attend an M2 camp is \$175 a day; we are and will continue to offer the camps in 2011 and 2012 for \$50 a session. Waupaca Boatride will continue to supplement the cost of the camps and also establish a fund with the camp entry fees to support youth volleyball in our state. The Waupaca Boatride has grown into the world's largest volleyball tournament by providing a great experience and excellent competition at an affordable price. Everyone in the Waupaca Boatride family does it for the love of the game and nothing more. All revenue generated from this event goes back into the event and to help youth organizations with fundraising ventures. We also want to make sure that everyone who comes to our event leaves having had a wonderful experience and their expectations fully met. Since we are not doing this for profit, we offer a 100% money back guarantee to those who choose not to attend, or if you are unhappy with the results of the M2 camp.

The camps will be run with 50 kids in each session, morning and afternoon for both days. Each camper will get a Misty May M2 shirt and have access to the tournament action all weekend long. We also have camping available on site for those that would like to stay and make it a one of a kind volleyball experience. The reason we limit the number of kids in each session is to allow a great one-on-one experience with all the skilled coaches. This is not going to be a generic drills camp - but one that looks improve each player's specific skills. We are fortunate to have many great high school and college coaches from around the area as they are also participating in the weekend tournament(s).
